Special Town Board Meeting
Monday, April 30, 2018 at 5:30 p.m.
Minutes

The Town Board of the Town of Bradford met at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, April 30, 2018 with Bill Johns and Ron Duffy at the intersection of Reid and Creek Roads to review, discuss and decide on the possible need for culvert extensions for the Creek Road culvert project before the culverts are ordered.

Present were Chair Sharon Douglas, Supervisors Sarah Pope, Loren Bobolz, Dan Huisheere and Ben Wellnitz, Clerk Sandra Clarke, Ron Duffy and Bill Johns.

The Board reviewed the site, with Bill Johns stating that he thought the culvert placement should be moved a little farther east to allow for the increase in the turn radius onto Reid Road. He also suggested a 3-foot extension of the length of the culvert.

The Board suggested the paver repair area be extended to the east and to the west for a total of approximately 77 feet. Bill Johns will check on the additional cost.

The Board went to the intersection of Highway 140 and B-C Townline Road. The Board reviewed the drawing and paint marks prepared by Ron Duffy showing the area with an 8-foot extension on the north end of the culvert and the resulting increase in turn radius. Bill Johns proposed a cost of \$2700.00 to complete the project with the increased area and an 8-foot galvanized steel extension on the culvert. No vote was taken. No objection was voiced by the Board Members.

Bill Johns stated that for the Waite Road paver repair project, he would replace the stop sign after the project was completed. Sharon Douglas stated that they had a new steel post and Loren Bobolz stated that he had a new wood post.
